

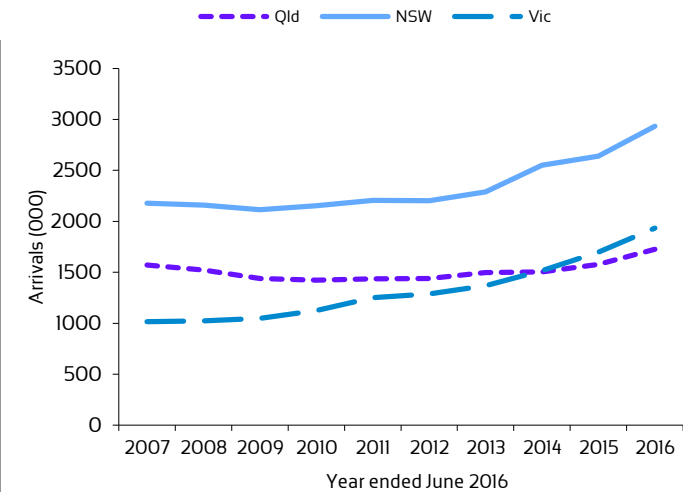

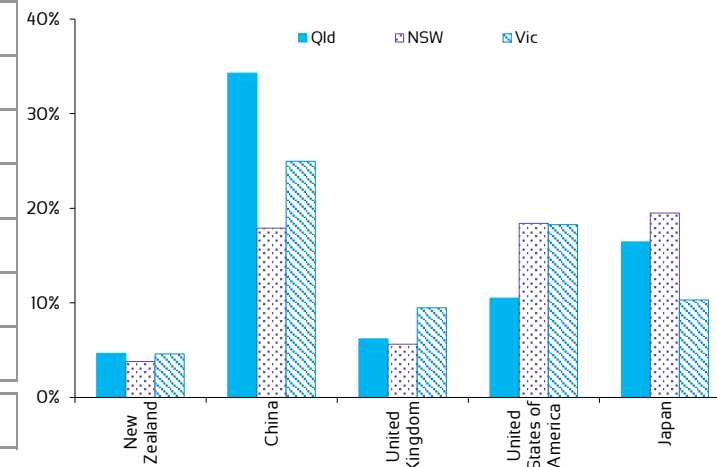

Annual change in visitor arrivals by source market



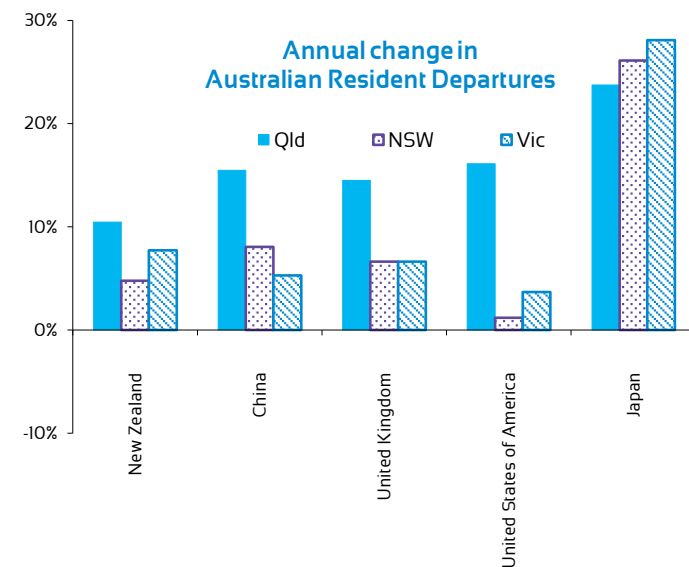
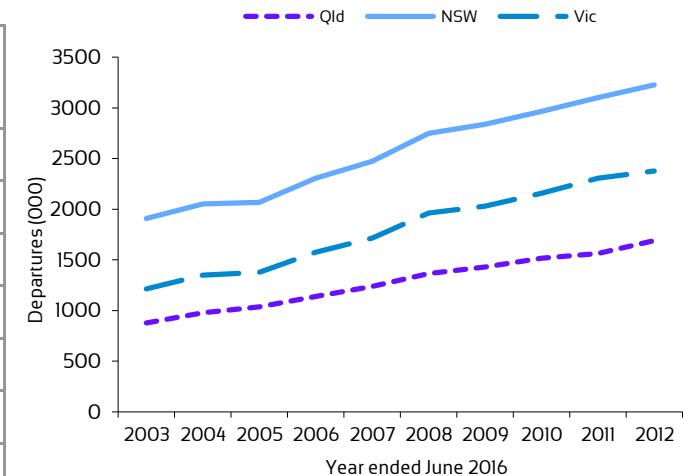

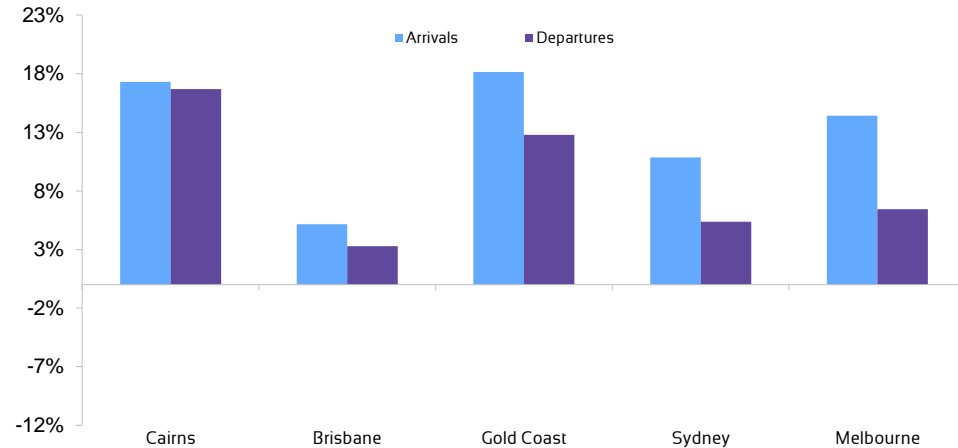
